Objective

We shall focus on and immerse ourselves in the literature for cello ensembles. The joy and experience of playing together is encouraged and broadened. You will familiarize yourselves with different forms of improvisation. This year, our special focus will be on the analysis and performance of J S Bach's cello suites. The ensembles are assembled at the beginning of the course according to the needs and skills of the participants. In the evening, all participants shall play in the cello orchestra.

Albert Roman, born in the Engadine, has studied with the great cellists of his time: André Navarra, Pierre Fournier, Mstislav Rostropovich, Paul Tortelier, and Janós Starker. First prizes at two international music competitions were the beginning of a busy concert and teaching activity in Europa, Asia, and the U.S. Albert Roman advocates contemporary music, with some compositions actually dedicated to him. For his contributions to the promotion of young Chinese talents, he was awarded the *Friendship Award* culture prize of the People's Republic of China. Albert Roman is Guest Lecturer at the music academies of Beijing, Tianjin, Shanghai, Wuhan, and Xi'an, Conductor of the *Swiss China Cello Orchestra*, and Artistic Director of *Chesa da Cultura* on Lake St. Moritz.
