

Contemporary Seminar for Composers and Instrumentalists with Dieter Ammann

The focus for this seminar is the comprehensive musical spectrum in the music of Dieter Ammann and his vast experience as an educator. The seminar is aimed at composers who wish to present their works (in group and one-on-one lessons) and at performers (individuals or ensembles) who would like to get to know the music of Dieter Ammann in open rehearsals and to be introduced to the world of contemporary music. The well-known Mondrian Ensemble will introduce chamber music by Dieter Ammann as well as excerpts from works by the participants. The works they study will be performed on 29.11.2016 at 20.30 in the closing concert. Dieter Ammann will be on hand throughout in the Chesa da Cultura as composer-in-residence.

Dieter Ammann

After conservatory training as well as studies at the Swiss Jazz School Bern began performing internationally as a musician. Studied theory and composition at the Music Academy of Basel (R. Moser, D. Müller-Siemens), taking courses with W. Lutoslawski, W. Rihm, D. Schnebel, and N. Castiglioni. At 30 turned to composition. Numerous awards, including main prize of the IBLA Foundation in honour of L. Berio, composition prize of the Siemens Music Foundation. Composer-in-residence at the Davos Festival, Festival Les muséigues, Lucerne Festival, Wittener Tage für neue Kammermusik, Sommerliche Musiktage Hitzacker, and reMusik Festival in St. Petersburg. His orchestral works have been conducted by P. Boulez, S. Cambreling, V. Gergiev, P. Heras-Casado, S. Mällki, J. Nott, S. Oramo, M. Pintscher, and P. Rundel; pieces for ensemble have been performed by the Klangforum Wien, the Ensemble Intercontemporain, the Quatuor Diotima, the Mondrian Ensemble among others. Ammann's music is published by Bärenreiter. He is professor at the Lucerne Academy of Music and also teaches at the University of the Arts in Bern.

Since it was founded in 2000, the **Mondrian Ensemble** has made its reputation as a formation that engages with modern and contemporary music as well as with the Classical-Romantic repertoire. The Ensemble has won several prizes and distinctions, including the Concours Nicati, the Swiss Ambassador Award, and the Working Year Scholarship for Musical Performance of the City of Zurich. In 2015 the Ensemble was admitted to the partnership program of the Fondation Nestlé pour l'Art. Many composers have written works for the Mondrian Ensemble (Dieter Ammann, Martin Jaggi, Rudolf Kelterborn, Detlev Müller-Siemens, Felix Profos among others). The Ensemble, which has also premiered works by Dieter Ammann, will concentrate on Après le silence (for piano trio), Gehörte Form (for string trio), and Piece for Cello by Ammann as well as excepts from selected works by the participating composers.

Composers and instrumentalists who are interested in the work of Dieter Ammann and who would like substantial feedback about their own work.
