

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

Master class in Viola da Gamba with Paolo Pandolfo

The course is aimed at Viola da Gamba students and professional musicians, as well as auditors and takes place from August 20 - 27, 2016 at the Chesa da Cultura on Lake St. Moritz. The opening will be on August 20, 2016 at 6 pm with a common dinner. The active participants have the opportunity to perform at the final concert on August 26, 2016 at 8:30 pm. Prof. Paolo Pandolfo will teach from 10 am - 1 pm and from 3 - 6 pm at the music hall of the Chesa da Cultura on Lake St. Moritz

Paolo Pandolfo is an Italian gambist und today one of the most important soloists in the European early music scene. His growing interest in Renaissance and Baroque music resulted in the creation of the ensemble La Stravaganza together with Rinaldo Alessandrini and Enrico Gatti. After completing his studies at the Roman Conservatory he immersed himself into the world of the Viola da Gamba at Schola Cantorum Basiliensis in 1981. Soon afterwards a fruitful musical collaboration began with his teacher Jordi Savall at the ensemble Hespèrion XX. Nine years later, in 1990, Paolo Pandolfo was appointed professor for Viola da Gamba at Schola Cantorum Basiliensis. His numerous recordings are published exclusively by Glossamusic since 1997. Paolo Pandolfo performs in the most prominent concert halls worldwide and gives master classes in Europe, Japan and the USA. (www.paolopandolfo.com)

Amélie Chemin (assistant) was born in France and lives today in Basel. She studied Violoncello, Chamber Music and Theory passing with distinction in Caen and Lyon. At the Schola Cantorum Basiliensis, she took up further studies in Baroque Cello and Viola da Gamba with Paolo Pandolfo, Petr Skalka and Randall Cook. In 2008, she graduated in Viola da Gamba. She participated in further courses with J. Hantaï, E. Guigues, M. Muller, J. Savall and P. Pierlot. In addition to her duo activity with Paolo Pandolfo, Amélie Chemin is member of the Baroque Orchestra La Cetra (Basel) and regularly works with the ensembles Opera Prima (Basel), Opera Musica (Basel), Concerto Scirocco (Lugano), Mare Nostrum (Belgium, Rome) and participates in numerous recordings (Deutsche Grammophon/ORF).
