

Master Class in Cello with Miklós Perényi

The course is aimed at cello students and professional musicians, as well as auditors and takes place from September 27 until October 4, 2016. The opening will be on September 27, 2016 at 6 p.m. with a common dinner. The active participants have the opportunity to perform at the final concert on October 3, 2016 at 8:30 p.m. During the course a pianist will accompany the participants. Prof. Miklós Perényi will teach from 10 am – 1 pm and from 4 – 7 pm at the music hall of the Chesa da Cultura on Lake St. Moritz.

Miklós Perényi (1948*) a native of Hungary, grew up in a family of musicians and had his first cello lessons at the age of five with Miklós Zsámboki, a student of David Popper. When he was nine he gave his debut concert in Budapest. He continued his education with Enrico Mainardi, Ede Banda, and the great Spanish cellist Pablo Casals and won the acclaimed Pablo Casals Cello Competition. Since 1980 Miklós Perényi has held a professorship at the Franz Liszt Academy in Budapest. He has received many awards and his musical career has taken him to the major music centres around the world. He regularly appears as a guest at the leading international music festivals. Through his outstanding musicianship and mastery of the cello, Miklós Perényi regularly collaborated with pianist András Schiff, who is among his closest colleagues. Perényi's numerous recordings include releases for Hungaroton, EMI, Sony Classical, Teldec, Decca, col legno, and Erato. His recording of Beethoven's complete works for cello and piano with András Schiff on ECM won the Cannes Classical Award in 2005.
